We invite you to be a vendor at our third annual *Mortlach Saskatoon Berry Festival!* We are expecting this to be another fun-filled day for the whole family. A variety of musical performers will entertain the entire day, parade, food vendors, crafts, displays, educational opportunities, and games for kids will keep everyone busy from morning 'til night!

**Rules for Vendors, Exhibitors and Concessions:**

**Food Vendors - \$100.00 – June 1, 2010 after June 1<sup>st</sup> - \$150.00**

**Crafts or Home Based Business Vendors - \$40.00 – June 1, 2010 deadline  
After June 1<sup>st</sup> - \$60.00 and will be a first come first served basis**

1. Booth cost must be received on or before June 1, 2010 in order to receive discount.
2. All booths will be outside. Please bring something for shade or rain. In the event of significant rain, the festival will move indoors to the arena.
3. Standard booth size is approximately 10 ft x 10 ft and can increase by 10 ft increments, ex: 10 ft x 20 ft - \$80.00
4. Requests for certain booth space will be accepted on a first come - first served basis. Please see the attached map of our village. Please choose your 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> preferences of location. However, allotment and placement of booths shall be at the discretion of the Mortlach Saskatoon Berry Festival Committee.
5. Booth set up is 7:00 – 9:00 am on the morning of Saturday, July 3, 2010
6. All unloading vehicles shall be off the booth area by 9:00 am.
7. Booths are to be set up and managed until 7:00 pm.
8. Booth take down is from 7:00pm – 9:00pm of the same day.
9. Exhibitors **must** provide their own tables, chairs, tents, displays, etc.
10. Anyone selling food or food products must comply with the relevant health regulations, i.e. cleanliness, packaging, temperature and garbage management. Vendors must determine the regulations themselves.
11. Vendors shall remove all of their own garbage off the festival site. Please bring garbage bags, cans, etc.
12. Absolutely No refunds.
13. The Village of Mortlach is not liable for any damages or injury that may occur as a result of the festival.
